IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Class Size and Instructors

Classes are limited to 20 children. Staff ratios are 10:1 for children aged 9–12, and 5:1 for children aged 6–8. Instructors hold degrees or diplomas, and have professional and teaching experience. Each group also has one or more teaching assistant(s) and/or volunteer(s) to provide additional support.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Entrance to the Education Centre at the Aga Khan Museum is via the Group Entrance. Parking is free ONLY for drop-off and pick-up purposes (10–15 minutes). Please sign your child in at the registration table inside.

Early-Bird Drop-off

Drop your child off between 8:30 am and 9 am for our free early-bird activities that are offered before official programming begins.

Extended Care

Available for those who have registered from 4 pm–6 pm. Extended care consisting of supervised activities will be available for children.

Daily Schedule

8:30 am–9 am — Pre-care/Drop-off
9 am–10:15 am — Gallery/Lesson
10:15 am–10:30 am — Break
10:30 am–12 pm — Lesson/Activity
12 pm–1 pm — Lunch
1 pm–2:15 pm — Gallery/Lesson
2:15 pm–2:30 pm — Break
2:30–4 pm — Lesson/Activity
4 pm–6 pm — Extended Care

* Please note that this is a general outline and there may be slight variation

Your Child's Safety/Pick-up

Children **MUST** be picked up promptly at the end of program or extended care. **A surcharge of \$1 per minute will be applied for late pick-ups.** Children are released only to people whose photo ID matches the name(s) submitted as authorized pick-up people. Names can be added to this list throughout the session. **Photo id is required every day for anyone who is picking up a camp participant.**

We do not permit children to leave unattended unless your child is 11–12 years of age and you have either selected this option on the Pick-Up Permission Form, or you have provided consent with a written note.

What should my child wear to Camp?

Campers must be dressed comfortably and appropriately, based on the weather (i.e., rain gear or sun hat/cool clothing for break time and outdoor play). For health and safety reasons, flip flops and roller shoes are not recommended at Camp.

Aga Khan Museum Camps are hands-on, arts activity-based programs, and Campers will be working with various objects and media. Campers are advised to wear clothes they do not mind getting paint and glue on.

What should my child bring to camp?

Your child's backpack should contain the following items:

1. A water bottle
2. Two snacks and drinks
3. Lunch
4. Sunscreen
5. A hat/sunglasses
6. An extra layer in case it gets chilly inside

We are a NUT AWARE camp. Please refrain from packing nuts in your child's lunch.

Belongings must be clearly labeled with the Camper's full name. They will be stored in the Camper's home base during the day.

Campers should refrain from bringing personal items such as iPods, mp3 players, electronic games, cellular phones, toys, or sports equipment to Camp.

The Aga Khan Museum is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please do not send valuables to camp. All personal items are the sole responsibility of the Camper for the duration of the program.
